

What does success look like?

1. A community of dwellings that receive the same treatment during conversion, despite the income of the prospective tenants and owners
2. Twenty-two households in homes they can afford
3. Ten households contributing to cross-subsidy
4. Dignity through confidentiality – information on OMV and %-owned/rented residents not shared or obvious in design and finish.
5. Salvation of a 1700s – 1900s rare example of a northern brewery to Heritage England Standards
6. Community of Ulverston included in celebration of the industrial past and creation of public area
7. Heritage skills training for Ulverston's unemployed
8. Some Ulverston people learn skills on site
9. Exemplar in renewable energy provision
10. Cohesive community of residents who respect all skills residents bring, be they academic, practical, social
11. Modular homes juxtaposed by historical cottages
12. Pedestrian thoroughfare gives access to Ulverston community and visitors to view houses and art installations
13. Shared area for additional storage leads to improved lifestyle for those in small homes
14. Shared areas for recreation or work leads to improved mental health and wellbeing.
15. Increased biodiversity of appropriate native species on site as a whole in consultation with Cumbria Wildlife Trust
